

Minutes of Public Hearing
of
CHEMUNG COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY

February 11, 2011

In accordance with Section 859-a (2) of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York, a public hearing was held at 9:00 a.m. on February 11, 2011, at the Horseheads Village Hall, 202 South Main Street, Horseheads, Chemung County, New York. Present were George Miner, President of STEG; Walter Herbst, Village Manager; and Sharron Cunningham, Village Clerk.

Mr. Miner opened the meeting at 9:00 a.m. and announced that the purpose of the hearing was to hear all interested persons regarding the request of Broad Street Apartments, LLC for the acquisition of an interest in five parcels of land containing an approximately 15.72 acre parcel of land at Sing Sing Road in the Village of Horseheads, Chemung County, New York; construction of twelve buildings containing twelve apartments each; and the acquisition of certain machinery and equipment. The Notice of Public Hearing was published in the Elmira Star Gazette on February 1, 2011. He then asked if anyone wished to speak either in favor or in opposition to the request and no one spoke.

There being no further appearances, the public hearing was declared closed at 9:16 a.m.
