

Minutes of Public Hearing
of
CHEMUNG COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY

May 3, 2010

In accordance with Section 859-a (2) of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York, a public hearing was held at 9:30 a.m. on May 3, 2010, at the Hazlett Building, 5th floor, 203 Lake Street, City of Elmira, Chemung County, New York. Present was Thomas J. Santulli, County Executive; George Miner, President of STEG; Jamie Johnson, Vice President of STEG; Mary Beth Fiore, Superintendent, Elmira Heights Central School District; and Sharon Chrisjohn, Recording Secretary.

Mr. Santulli opened the meeting at 9:31 a.m. and announced that the purpose of the hearing was to hear all interested persons regarding the request of Anchor Glass Container Corporation (formerly Diamond Thatcher, Inc.) for a Fourth Amendment to Payment in Lieu of Tax Agreement to extend the term of the Payment in Lieu of Tax Agreement. The Notice of Public Hearing was published in the Elmira Star Gazette on April 20, 2010. He then asked if anyone wished to speak either in favor or in opposition to the request and the following person spoke:

Mary Beth Fiore stated that in reading the document, she has the following concerns; there does not appear to be any distinction between full time and part-time employees; the length of the extended PILOT and percentage of diminution.
