

Minutes of Public Hearing  
of  
CHEMUNG COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY

June 22, 2009

In accordance with Section 859-a (2) of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York, a public hearing was held at 9:30 a.m. on June 22, 2009, at the Horseheads Village Hall, 202 South Main Street, Village of Horseheads, Chemung County, New York. Present were Thomas J. Santulli, County Executive; George Miner, President of STEG; Donald Zeigler, Horseheads Village Mayor; Walter Herbst, Village Trustee; Michael Stuart, Horseheads Central School District; and Sharon Chrisjohn, Recording Secretary.

Mr. Santulli opened the meeting at 9:31a.m. and announced that the purpose of the hearing was to hear all interested persons regarding the application of Schlumberger Technology Corporation of the acquisition of an approximately 88.5 acre parcel of land located on E Street in the Horseheads Commercial Development Center; construction of approximately 7 buildings containing in the aggregate approximately 400,000 sq. ft. of space to constitute a gas services campus and related activities; and acquisition and installation of certain machinery and equipment. The Notice of Public Hearing was published in the Elmira Star Gazette on May 21, 2009. He then asked if anyone wished to speak either in favor or in opposition to the project and the following spoke:

Mr. Herbst and Mr. Zeigler are both very much in favor of the project.

There being no further appearances, the public hearing was declared closed at 9:34 a.m.
