

Minutes of Public Hearing
of
CHEMUNG COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY

July 1, 2008

In accordance with Section 859-a (2) of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York, a public hearing was held at 11:00 a.m. on July 1, 2008, at the Hazlett Building, 5th floor 203 Lake Street, City of Elmira, Chemung County, New York. Present were Michael Krusen, Deputy County Executive; George Miner, President of STEG; and Sharon Chrisjohn, Recording Secretary.

Mr. Krusen opened the meeting at 11:00 a.m. and announced that the purpose of the hearing was to hear all interested persons regarding the application of Chemung County Performing Arts, Inc. consisting of acquisition of an approximately 1 acre parcel of land located at 207 Clemens Center Parkway in the City of Elmira, together with an approximately 67,937 sq. ft. building, renovation of the existing facility, construction of an approximately 17,940 sq. ft. addition, and acquisition and installation of certain machinery and equipment to constitute a performing arts center and related activities. The Notice of Public Hearing was published in the Elmira Star Gazette on May 30, 2008. He then asked if anyone wished to speak either in favor or in opposition to the project.

There being no appearances, the public hearing was declared closed at 11:02 a.m.
