

Minutes of Public Hearing
of
CHEMUNG COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY

July 1, 2008

In accordance with Section 859-a (2) of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York, a public hearing was held at 9:30 a.m. on July 1, 2008, at the Horseheads Village Hall, 202 South Main Street, Village of Horseheads, Chemung County, New York. Present were George Miner, President of STEG; and Sharon Chrisjohn, Recording Secretary.

Mr. Miner opened the meeting at 9:33 a.m. and announced that the purpose of the hearing was to hear all interested persons regarding the application of Klugo Enterprises LLC consisting of acquisition of an approximately 3.90 acre parcel of land located at 901 South Avenue in the Village of Horseheads together with an existing building containing approximately 73,323 sq. ft., renovation and/or reconstruction of the facility, and acquisition and installation of certain machinery and equipment to constitute a multi-tenant office, distribution and storage facility to be leased to various tenants. The Notice of Public Hearing was published in the Elmira Star Gazette on May 31, 2008. He then asked if anyone wished to speak either in favor or in opposition to the project.

There being no appearances, the public hearing was declared closed at 9:35 a.m.
