

Minutes of Public Hearing
of
CHEMUNG COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY

August 14, 2009

In accordance with Section 859-a (2) of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York, a public hearing was held at 9:30 a.m. on August 14, 2009, at the Horseheads Town Hall, 150 Wygant Road, Town of Horseheads, Chemung County, New York. Present were George Miner, President of STEG; Jack Moore, Attorney for Seneca Beverage; Dave Blauvelt, IBEW; and Sharon Chrisjohn, Recording Secretary.

Mr. Miner opened the meeting at 9:30 a.m. and announced that the purpose of the hearing was to hear all interested persons regarding the application of Seneca Beverage Corp. of the acquisition of an approximately 14.953.5 acre parcel of land located at 2081 and 2085 Lake Road in the Town of Horseheads; construction of a warehouse containing approximately 91,900 sq. ft. of space; a garage to contain approximately 5,000 sq. ft. of space and associated parking to constitute a beverage distribution warehouse facility and related activities; and acquisition and installation of certain machinery and equipment. The Notice of Public Hearing was published in the Elmira Star Gazette on July 15, 2009. He then asked if anyone wished to speak either in favor or in opposition to the project and the following spoke:

Mr. Blauvelt is very much in favor of the project and is here to support John Potter.

There being no further appearances, the public hearing was declared closed at 9:35 a.m.
